Teaching Timetable

'What Catches My Eye?'

Writing

We will begin with writing sports based on the book we are reading in class, 'The Final Year.'

Following that we will write stories based on the book.

In the run-up to SATS, we will be revising for the Grammar Punctuation and Spelling Test.

After half-term we will be writing diaries based on our most memorable moments at Crich Carr, which we will be turning into pop-up books.

Computing

In computing we will be learning how computers sense and respond to information. After half-term we will be continuing to learn about computer-aided design and 3-d modeling.

Arŧ

In Art & Design this term we will be learning about pop artist David Hockney, looking in particular at his photo-collages. We will experiment with taking photos using the lpads then creating our own photo-collages.

After half-term we will study textiles and use our knowledge to create our own designs.



Science

In science this term we will be learning about plants, as well as learning about properties of materials and how materials can change.

PSHE

This term we will be discussing 'What Makes Us Proud.' We will also look at the different changes we might face in life, including starting at a new school. We will also be looking at how our bodies change as we grow up.

Music

In music children will be building their skills in the lom to Improvise' unit, practicing playing notes that lie further apart. After half-term the children will be planning performances in small group in 'Farewell tour.'



RE

Our topic this half-term is 'If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?' Then after half-term we will consider 'Is it better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?'

Reading

We have started reading 'The Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow, which recounts the tumultuous final year at an inner-city primary school.

Following that we will be reading 'Skellig' by David Almond. In guided reading we will be reading texts about art movements and about famous artists.

Then we will be reading playscripts so that the Class 3 children can select the play for our end of year performance.

Children will develop their key reading skills through directed practise of word meanings, retrieval, inference, summary, sequencing, comparison, explanation and prediction.



Maths

As mathematicians, we will be looking at properties of shapes, both 2-d and 3-d. We will make nets to create 3-d shapes.

We will be learning about angles, including: measuring angles, calculating angles in a triangles, quadrilaterals and polygons,

Finally, we will learn about coordinates in four quadrants and how to reflect and translate shots before plotting the new coordinates.

French

We learn about how to tell the time as well as how to discuss our holidays and hobbies.
